NCGASA Derby Rules

1. All Participants (Adults & Youths) must be paid for derby before 6:00 am of the event August 31, 2019. Payments can be made via PayPal or in person at Little Ray's Tackle the morning of the event. Derby costs of \$70 will cover the entry to the event, annual membership to NCGASA, BBQ lunch, free raffle ticket. There is a youth division also for under 16 years old on day of event paying out one winner (All ramp Launch fees are NOT INCLUDED) Participates based on 100 anglers and cash prizes subjective to change! \$50 Entry if you have current membership. Lunch tickets will be provided at weigh in with proof of derby entry. You MUST BE A MEMBER TO FISH OUR DERBY! Sign up with entry
2. Payouts will be as followed. 1st place 2nd place 3rd place Youth payout totaling 5 winners. All payouts will be written check from NCGASA
3. All people on a derby vessel must be in the derby. For example: IF there are 4 people in a boat they all must be registered in the derby. 2-3 people CANNOT fish as a team for one person. Any cheating on this will be a forfeiture of all monies paid. Only exception is licensed guides do not have to be entered. Any Licensed guide entered into derby must be a member of NCGASA to avoid paying derby entry fee. One guide maximum per boat, any deckhands must be entered as a participate in the derby.
4. The boundaries of the Derby Hwy. 96 Bridge at Weitchpec to the Klamath mouth.
5. Fishing hours are on August 31, 2019 only from hour before sunrise to 3 pm. All Entrants must be in line before 4 p.m. Weigh In takes place at Old Redwood Rest campground and weigh in starts at 2 pm and finishes by 4 p.m. All awards and raffle will start after weigh in is complete. Lunch will be served from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm.
6. Measuring device and scale will be provided by NCGASA board and used for all the same fish. All fish will be weighed gutted and gilled. Upon an exact tie in weight with 3 Board of Directors confirming a tie. The winner will be decided by length. All fish within 1pound of the target weight will be measured. All disputes will be solved by NCGASA Rep.
7. All fish must be caught in the mouth by rod and reel.
8. All extra monies and proceeds go to help fight to save our fisheries and wildlife in Northern CA. NCGASA is a 501 (c)4 non-profit organization and all donations are 100% tax write off. Tax ID # 680294956.
9. All entrants and people helping will derby understand the risks involved with fishing and boating on rivers and are required to follow all CA department of boating and waterways procedures and California Department of Fish and Wildlife rules. All entrants must carry all boating safety equipment on their own vessels. All fish must be caught in the mouth and landed legally by hand or net. All derby fish must be taken to Old Redwood Rest campground for weigh in and measuring location between 2-4 p.m. Winners will be subject to Polygraph Test and Local Police investigation upon any form of foul play or cheating by the board of directors.
10. All entrants must follow all local, state and federal laws in this derby. All fish and wildlife laws are required to be followed. NCGASA reserves the right to dis qualify any participate if the salmon weighed in does not look freshly caught. Participate agrees to this rule by entering the derby. (our suggestion is to take a picture of your fish with some sort of timed date stamp to qualify)
